## **Friends of Stanton Hill Activity Report**

Attendance at meetings is increasing. The current activities are:

- 1. Spring Fayre 11th. May, 12-3pm at the Starbox Gym. Tables advertising a mixture of commercial and voluntary activities. Attractions for children, brass band, refreshments. Does the Forum want a table and if so who will organise the material for it and be in attendance on the day?
- 2. Working with Ashfield DC on improvements to public spaces including the weeding and planting the large bed by the traffic island and possibly an orchard off Wharf Road. Co-op now on board and very supportive in terms of staff time and materials.
- 3. Regular litter picks in an attempt to improve the area's appearance.
- 4. Contact made with Ashfield Voluntary Enterprise on Brierley Park Industrial Estate. They teach woodwork and other practical skills currently to people with learning difficulties. Scope to expand this to form a hub where people from Stanton Hill can socialise and learn new skills, together with a centre where broken items can be repaired.
- 5. Liaising with Inspire (Library Service) who are prepared to provide courses at Skegby Library. They will be at the Spring Fayre and will be carrying out a survey to determine the type of courses that will be suitable.
- 6. A representative of Long Reign Allotment Association attended the last meeting and discussions have started on how they can contribute to the work that FOSH is doing.
- 7. Following the Spring Fayre it is hoped to work on a Christmas event in conjunction with Stanton Hill Co-op. Tracey, the Manager, attended the last meeting. The Co-op is collecting donations for an event which is likely to be a Santa's Grotto at the Starbox Gym with presents for the children who come. FOSH will help organise this.
