
Teversal, Stanton Hill and Skegby Neighbourhood Forum & Neighbourhood Area

In accordance with the provisions of the legislation, Ashfield District Council has designated:

- a) The Teversal, Stanton Hill and Skegby Neighbourhood Forum.
- b) The Teversal, Stanton Hill and Skegby Neighbourhood Area.

This is the initial stage in bringing forward a neighbourhood plan. A neighbourhood plan is a new type of plan, in which the local community decides where development should happen in their neighbourhood. In non parished areas, it is brought forward by a local community group designated as a neighbourhood forum. Once adopted the neighbourhood plan will be utilised in considering any planning applications in the area.
